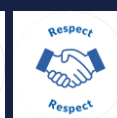

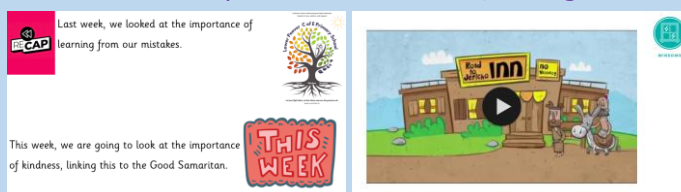


Collective Worship
