School Lunches – Allergens & Intolerances

As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping all children safe, we kindly ask parents/carers to update us with any changes to your child's allergy or intolerance information.

If your child has developed a new allergy or intolerance, outgrown an existing one, or if there are any updates to their medication or medical advice, please inform the school office as soon as possible.

Our catering team do require medical evidence for children with allergens that must come from a health practitioner. These are provided free of charge on request. This can be in any of the following forms:

- Hospital referral letter
- Doctor's letter
- Allergy Action Plan
- School Health Care Plan.

Unfortunately, we are unable to accept self-diagnosis, commercial or home tests that have been undertaken. Once this information is collected, our catering company will then devise a safe dietary plan for your child.

Morning Snack

We are seeing an increasing number of children bringing in large family size bags of crisps, chocolate bars & packs of sweets for snack.

A reminder that children are only allowed one SMALL healthy item for morning snack on Monday to Thursday and one SMALL item on 'treat' Friday. Sweets & fizzy drinks are not permitted on any day.

Staff will be monitoring what the children are bringing in. Thank you for your co-operation.
