Collective Worship

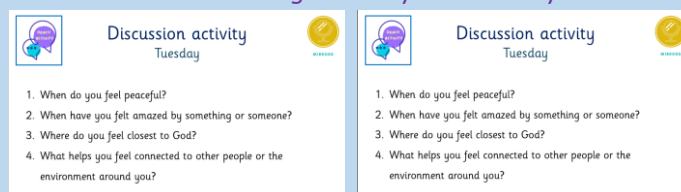
During class worship this week, the key question was...Who has shown that they are an image of God?
