Lower Peover Whole School '1,000 Hours Readathon Challenge' Monday 16th March – Monday 30th March 2026

To promote the children's love of reading and celebrate 'The National Year of Reading 2026', we are launching a whole school two-week 'Readathon challenge'. The 'Readathon challenge' is for the whole school to accumulate a combined total of 1,000 hours of reading over the course of a two-week period. This will run between Monday **16th March to Monday 30th March**.

You will all receive full information by email on Monday, along with a printed copy of the Readathon Record Sheet that will be sent home with the children. Unfortunately, if these record sheets are misplaced, we are unable to print further copies, so please do keep them safe. The record sheet will also be attached to the email if you need to print further copies yourselves.
