Maths Measurement – We will learn what area is and understand how to find the area of a range of shapes by counting squares.

Science In this unit we will be learning how sound is made by vibrations. We will be investigating different ways to make sounds and comparing them. We will also investigate whether sound can be blocked and see if sound travels differently through solids, liquids and gas.

RE Hindu Dharma – In this topic we will think about the symbol of light and identify where we can see goodness in the world. We will then move on to discuss Diwali and understand why this is an important festival for Hindus.

Computing The children will discuss ownership of digital audio and discuss copyright when it comes to duplicating the work of others. Children will then learn how to record themselves and edit recordings. Finally, we will learn how to give feedback to our peers to help make improvements.
