## Winter Wonderland

Explore your garden or a park with your child to search for signs of winter. Can your child identify a deciduous tree and an evergreen tree? Can any wildlife be seen? If there has been a frost, encourage your child to explore the patterns and textures of frozen leaves. If there has been snow, look out for animal and bird tracks.

Some animals live in cold places around the world. Draw a picture in your learning log of an animal that lives in a cold place and find out a fact to share with the class about your animal.

If temperatures are forecast to fall below freezing overnight, you can create some unusual ice sculptures as well as have the opportunity to talk about freezing and melting. Fill a latex glove with water, tie up the end and leave it outside. In the morning carefully unpeel the glove and you will have a frozen hand! I can provide a glove, just message on class dojo.

Sammy squirrel hid 8 nuts for the winter. He has already eaten 5 of them. How many nuts has he got left?
You could draw a picture in your learning log or use your fingers to help you work out the answer.

In your learning log, design a scarf. You could draw it, paint it or even use other materials to make a collage.

We are reading the story *Stickman* this half term in class. Can you draw the characters in *Stickman* in your learning log and then try to write their name. Give 'man' 'dog' 'Mum' and 'Dad' a go!
