Reading – Stormbreaker, Anthony Horowitz

We will be exploring the 'spy' genre whilst exploring how authors build up tension and excitement in narratives

History - The Invasion and Settlement of the Vikings

We will be using historical sources to investigate how Britain changed as a result of the arrival of the Vikings. We will learn about King Alfred the Great and the Danelaw whilst examining artefacts and to discover what everyday life was like for the people of the time.

Computing – Data and Spreadsheets

This unit introduces the learners to spreadsheets. They will be supported in organising data into columns and rows to create their own data set. Pupils will be taught the importance of formatting data to support calculations, while also being introduced to formulas and will begin to understand how they can be used to produce calculated data.

Maths

As well as regular fluency practise, we will be concentrating on;

Area, Perimeter and Volume

Finding areas of rectangular compound shapes, triangles and parallelograms and finding volumes of cuboids

Statistics

Pie charts with percentages, line and bar graphs as well as finding the mean average

Shape

Finding the internal and external angles, the faces and edges of 3D shapes, Positioning 2D shapes and translating/ reflecting them accurately.

Science - Healthy Bodies

Children will learn about the importance of a balanced diet and exercise, learning about how nutrients and water are transported in the human body, how the heart and muscles function and adapt to exercise and investigate the effects of tobacco, alcohol and other drugs.

The children will write in role as a doctor, to give advice to fictional 'patients' on how to improve their health and lifestyle

PSHCE -

Understanding media bias, including social media Caring: communities and the environment Earning and saving money

RE - Christianity, Jesus

We will explore the events leading up to and including the death of Jesus

Explain how beliefs about the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus might guide and comfort a Christian during difficult times in their own life.
