Autumn 1		Year 2	
English	In English this half-term, we are learning to write a diary entry about a space flight. We will be reading the book Look Up by Nation Byron . We are building our knowledge of punctuation and using capital letters and full stops accurately. We are also learning to use expanded noun phrases to describe and using subordination (because) and coordination (and).		
Maths	In Maths, we begin Year 2 focusing on place value with numbers up to 100. We will count, write and partition numbers as well as order and compare different numbers within 100. We will use lots of practical resources including base 10, place value charts and number lines.		
Science	Our Science topic, is Animals including humans . We will be finding the answer to the question “do all animals start off small?” We will sequence and describe the life cycle of different animals and explain the different stages in the human life cycle. This unit also links to healthy living and good hygiene.		
History	In History, we are learning all about The Great Fire of London . We are exploring what happened during the fire and why it spread so quickly. We are also excited to have visitors coming in to school to enhance our learning with outdoor learning opportunities!		
Art/DT	In DT this half-term, Mrs Sanchez is teaching the children all about Mechanisms – Sliders and Levers . The children will be creating their very own moving pictures!		
Computing	In Computing, we will be finding out about information technology . We will talk about systems and networks and identify different types of computers. This links closely with e-safety and how we stay safe online.		
PSHE	Our topic in PSHE is all about ourselves and our relationships .		
PE	In PE, we will be looking at two different units. On Monday, we will exploring throwing and catching to help us learn different tatics to win a game of piggy in the middle! On Fridays, we will be focusing on outdoor adventurous activities with a link to building teamwork skills. Children will need to bring their PE kits on both days.		
RE	Our RE topic is Christianity (God) and in this unit we will look at how Christians see God as a creator.		
Music	In Music, we will be look at pulse, rhythm and pitch. The children will learn how music has a pulse (a steady beat) and that it is made up of long and short and high and low sounds called rhythm and pitch.		
Homework & Spellings	<p>For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly, practise their spellings and complete their weekly maths homework. This is due in on a Thursday. Spellings will be sent home in your child’s home learning book, on a Friday, and tested the following week in school.</p> <p>There will also be a whole school core value challenge you can complete if you want to.
