## Curriculum Planner

Autumn 1		Year 1	
English	In English this half-term we are reading the text Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. We are learning to write our own adventure story using the structure of Lost and Found but with a new animal.		
Maths	We are developing our number knowledge by studying place value. We will be sorting and comparing objects, counting them, writing numbers as words and counting on from any number. This half-term will consolidate our number knowledge within 20.		
Science	In Science, we are studying Animals including humans. We will exploring which animals belong to different groups and which animals are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.		
Geography	This half-term builds on our place knowledge of our own local area. We will be learning which countries make up the United Kingdom and naming the surrounding seas. We will study our capital city London in greater detail.		
DT	This term, Year 1 will study the engineers The Wright Brothers and learn how to design, build and evaluate their own piece of playground equipment, working together to create a class model playground.		
Computing	We will be developing our understanding of technology this half-term. We will be learning how technology can help us in the wider world and becoming familiar with different components of a computer.		
PSHE	As always in Autumn 1, this half-term is about developing relationships and settling into Year 1. The children will build on their Reception year helping them to develop emotionally and socially.		
PE	On Mondays, Year 1 will develop Fundamental Movement Skills, beginning with rolling a ball. On Fridays, they will complete the Baseline Unit – Lost and Found, focusing on movement and physical confidence.		
RE	Our RE topic this half-term is Christianity. We will begin to understand who God is and why Christians follow God.		
Music	In Music, we are beginning to introduce beat. We will build on the work of Reception where children began to copy simple rhythms and patterns.		
Homework & Spellings	For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly and complete their maths homework which will be sent home on a Friday. Children have access to numbots which is a brilliant online game to help with their maths learning – Miss Barrington will sent home the details for this ☺ Please can reading books and homework be handed in on a Thursday ready to be changed on a Friday.
