Autumn 2		Year 6	
English	In English, the children are learning about how to save endangered animals using the book 'Can we save the tiger?' by Martin Jenkins. Pupils will be able to write their own booklet based on an amazing animal including elements of information, explanation and persuasion. We will continue to consolidate and building on the children's spelling, punctuation and grammar skills throughout our lessons each week. To fit in with our history topic, our class novel is 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell		
Maths	In the first two weeks, we will be finishing our four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) topic, which we started before half term. Children will practise long division, solve problems with division and learn to order operations (BIDMAS). We will then move onto our Fractions topic. In the first part of this topic the children will be learning to simplify, order and compare fractions as well as learning to solve addition, subtraction, multiplication and division questions involving fractions. In the second half of the topic, the children will be looking at equivalent fractions, finding fractions of amounts, converting fractions to decimals and percentages. Finally, children will be applying their knowledge of fractions to solve real-life problems and multi-step problems.		
Science	Evolution and inheritance Children will learn that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide evidence of organisms that lived millions of years ago. They will also understand that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but with variations that make each individual unique. Additionally, they will explore how animals and plants adapt to their environments in different ways, and how these adaptations can lead to evolution over time.		
History	This half-term, our history topic is 'Were the Vikings really vicious?' We will explore the Viking raids, their settlements in Britain, and their interactions with the Anglo-Saxons. Children will learn about Viking culture, beliefs, and the impact they had on Britain, considering whether they were truly as fierce as they are often portrayed. Through historical sources and evidence, they will develop their skills in historical enquiry and critical thinking		
Art/DT	Textiles During this unit of learning, children will consider a range of factors in their design criteria to create a product. They will use a design to embroider and use 3D effects to attach pieces of fabric then employ a running stitch to join it and make a functional product. Finally, they will evaluate their final product.		
Computing	Web Page Creation During these lessons, children will be learning how to design and create their own websites using Google Sites. They will explore what makes a		

	good website, including layout, content, and navigation. Students will also learn about the importance of copyright and fair use of media. Throughout the unit, they will plan, create, and evaluate their web pages, paying attention to aesthetics and user experience.
PSHE	Valuing difference Children will be learning about the importance of diversity and inclusion. They will learn to recognise and celebrate the differences and similarities between people, fostering mutual respect and understanding. The lessons will cover topics such as respecting others' viewpoints, understanding prejudice and discrimination, and the importance of kindness and empathy in building positive relationships. As part of enrichment, the children will have their Commando Joe session. These sessions will focus on our core values.

RE	Hinduism – Is there one journey or many? In this unit children will be learning what Hindus believe about the cycle of life, death and rebirth.
Music	Learning and singing songs and dances for our Christmas Show
French	Seasons and weather
