	Spring 1	Year 2
English	This term we will be reading the book Grandad's Camper by Harry Woodgate. At the end of this unit of work, we will write our own stories based around this text, changing the characters and locations.	
Maths	In maths, we will start by studying money. We will recognise and count coins and notes whilst making different amounts. Then we will solve problems that involve finding change. Our next topic is multiplication and division. Here we will focus on our 2x, 5x and 10x tables. We will practise dividing by grouping and sharing. We will also use arrays. We will continue to practise doubling and halving as well as finding odd and even numbers with increasingly larger numbers.	
Science	In science, we will be learning about Living things and their habitats. Throughout these lessons we will be thinking about the question, Is everything on Earth alive? We will learn that living things move, grow, consume nutrients and reproduce. We will also learn that dead things used to do these things but no longer do and that things that have never lived have never done these things.	
History	In History, we are learning all about the Victorians. We will explore how life has changed and how school life has changed. We will finalise our topic with our school trip to Tatton Park for a living history day.	
DT	In DT, during our enrichment sessions, we will be looking at cooking different foods. We will experiment with different tastes and make our own fruit salad.	
Computing	In computing, we will be programming using the Bee-Bot floor robots. We will develop our understanding of instructions in sequences and use logical reasoning to predict outcomes	
PSHE	In PSHE, we will be finding out how to 'keep safe'. We will discuss how medicines can make us feel better if we are ill, identify situations in which we would feel safe or unsafe and identify situations in which we would need to say 'Yes', 'No', 'I'll ask', or 'I'll tell'.	
PE	In PE, we will be looking at two different units. On Monday, we will be studying historic playground games. On Fridays, we will be focusing on dance with a sports coach . Children will need to bring their PE kits on both days.	
RE	Our RE topic is Hindu Dharma. Our focus question will be 'How should we respond to the things that really matter?' We will identify a special event or person and think about how this makes us feel.	
Music	In music, we will be exploring our feelings through music. We will celebrate a wide range of musical styles and sing songs that will help us examine 'How Does Music Make the World a Better Place?	
Homework & Spellings	For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly, practise their spellings and complete their weekly maths homework. This is due in on a Thursday. Spellings will be sent home in your child's home learning book, on a Friday, and tested the following Monday in school.
