#### Year Five

<b>English</b>	Based on Malala's Magic Pencil by Malala Yousafzai we will be writing a recount in the form of an autobiography. We will also develop our use of relative clauses and more advanced punctuation.
<b>Maths</b>	In maths, we will continue our work on converting and solving puzzles involving fractions before looking at formal methods for long multiplication and division.
<b>Science</b>	Earth and Space is our topic for this half term, looking at facts about planets in our solar system, the moon and how the earth's orbit influences climates and seasons.
<b>Geography</b>	What does North America have in common with the UK? This topic looks at the countries in North America, the American states and the range of biomes on this vast continent.
<b>Art/DT</b>	We will be making designing and creating bags in Design Technology this half term using stitching and decorative techniques to create a practical and aesthetically pleasing product.
<b>Computing</b>	Our computing unit looks at selecting in computing using Vector Drawing.
<b>PSHE</b>	We will look at ways to keeping ourselves safe as our independence grows and will talk about ways we can access help if needed.
<b>PE</b>	We will be looking at gymnastics, which will focus on balances travelling and creating sequences using these. Our Thursday session is a dance unit and we are using the theme of space to inspire movements.
<b>RE</b>	We will be looking at Hinduism and what might Hindus learn from stories about Krishna.
<b>Music</b>	In music, we are learning how to compose pieces of music and developing our use of chords.
<b>French</b>	In French, we will be looking at different food and how to say what we like and dislike and how to order food in French.
<b>Homework &amp; Spellings</b>	For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly, practise their spellings and complete their weekly maths homework. This is due in on a Thursday. Spellings will be sent home in your child's home learning book, on a Friday, and tested the following Friday in school.
