Spring 2	Reception
English - Literacy	In our English, we are reading traditional tales with a focus on "The Gingerbread man." We are learning to recall familiar stories and write a simple narrative using simple sentences. The children will use their segmenting skills to break down CVC words to spell them and now begin to apply finger spaces, capital letters and full stops to their writing.
Maths	In Maths, we follow the White Rose Hub maths scheme. We will continue using a mastery approach and continue to learn more about the composition of numbers to 10. The children will begin to recall key number bonds to 10. Later in the term, we will explore 3D shapes and begin to learn the names of them.
Understanding the World	Our topic this half-term links closely with our English and is all about traditional tales. This topic focuses on learning about different types of traditional tales including fables and morals. We will be reading a range of traditional tales including Hansel and Gretel and traditional fables such as the boy who cried wolf.
Expressive Arts and Design	In DT this half-term, we will begin to learn about a designer called Alexander Bell! His most famous invention was the telephone. The children will explore different types of telephones including those from the past, before designing and making their own plastic telephones!
Personal, Social and Emotional	In PSHE, this half-term is all about rights and respect. We will be talking about how we can help other people both at home and school. This unit focuses on kindness and what we can do to help people in our local community.
PE	<p>This half-term PE will be on a Wednesday. We will be developing our fundamental movement skills through a range of activities. The children will practise jumping, travelling over, under and through balance and climbing equipment, and moving with control and coordination. We will also be learning to catch, beginning with large sponge balls and then improving our accuracy. Later in the unit, we will explore rolling in a variety of ways and finish by revisiting and refining all the movement skills we have learned.</p> <p>Please make sure all uniform and PE kits are labelled with names.</p>

Homework & Spellings

For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly and practise the sounds they have learnt. This term reading books will be changed on a Wednesday. We will send home a phonic activity or a Maths activity every alternate week. This is due in on a Thursday. Maths activities can be shared on dojo.
