



Stubbins Primary School Curriculum Planner

Spring 2	Year 2
English	In English this half-term we are reading the text Major Dizzy and Major Glad, a wonderful story that takes us back in time. The children will learn how to write in the past and present progressive tense and use the conjunctions because, when and that. The final writing piece will be a recount in the form of a diary.
Maths	We are further developing our knowledge of multiplication and division in relation to the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will then move on to measures and will compare and order length and height.
Science	In Science, we are studying plants. The children will learn about the functions of the different parts of a plant, the life cycle of a plant and will grow a broad bean to watch how plants develop.
Geography	In Geography this term the children are learning about the different biomes around the world.
Art/DT	In Art, we are learning all about weaving and the Artist Judith Scott. We will be creating our own piece of weaving based on the Great Fire of London.
Computing	We will be developing our understanding of collecting and representing data. The children will learn how to use a tally chart to collect data and then transfer the information into a pictogram. Following this they will answer questions about the data they have collected.
PSHE	In PSHE, the children will be learning about Rights and Respect. The children will learn strategies to help them make good choices when getting along with others and how to control impulsive behaviour. They will also learn about playing games that are safe and enjoyable as well as exploring ways to look after the environment.
PE	In PE, we are developing our games and ball skills in the first weekly session.
RE	Our RE topic this half-term is Islam. The children will learn about special times to pray, the act of Wudu, the Mosque and the importance of God in a Muslim's life.
Music	In Music, the children are learning the classic song "I am the music man". They will find the rhythm of the music and learn the song before adding percussion. They will focus on notes E,F,G,A, C.
Homework & Spellings	For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly, practise their spellings and complete their weekly maths homework. This is due in on a Thursday. Spellings will be sent home in your child's home learning book, on a Friday, and tested the following Monday in school. There will also be a whole school core value challenge you can complete if you want to. We would love to see photos/ videos on class dojo! These will be celebrated at the end of the half-term.
