Spring 2	Year 4
English	In English, we are working on writing an adventure narrative based on our text Amazing Islands and a story called Koji's island..
Maths	One of our key focuses remains to be learning our times tables with lots of opportunities to use TTRockstars in preparation for the times table screen in a few weeks' time. We are also looking at fractions in detail, in particular addition and subtraction of fractions with common denominators.
Science	Our Science unit this half term is Changing States. We look at solids, liquids and gases and how these can be changed and sometimes reversed. We also learn about the water Cycle and link this back to our last geography unit about rivers to help consolidate learning.
History	Our history learning is based on the Great Plague – a gory topic all about rats, boils and death!
Art	In art this half term we will be looking at printing.
Computing	This half term we will be looking at photo editing and experiment with how photos can be changed.
PSHE	We will be considering how we can keep safe this half term in both the real and digital world.
PE	This half term we will be doing gymnastics and handball.
RE	The children will look at the Christianity and the temptation and sacrifice of lent.
Music	Our music unit focuses on interesting time signatures and developing improvisation skills.
French	In French, we will look at asking and answering questions and school subjects.
