Summer 1	Reception
English - Literacy	In our English, we are reading "Hattie Peck The Journey Home" by Emma Levey. We are learning to retell and rewrite the story using sentences which include capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be applying all our own Level 2 and Level 3 sound knowledge and we will begin to write longer words including four and five sound words or two-syllable words.
Maths	In Maths, we follow the White Rose Hub maths scheme. We will be continue using a mastery approach and begin to learn about the composition of numbers beyond 10 up to 20. The children will use ten frames to see that numbers beyond 10 are made up of 10 and some more. We will use the vocabulary related to place value and talk about numbers like 14 being made up of 1 lot of 10 and 4 ones.
Understanding the World	Our topic this half-term is called Grow with Me. This topic focuses on learning about plants and trees as well as different minibeasts and their habitats. We will also begin to explore simple life cycles of animals.
Expressive Arts and Design	In Art this half-term, we will begin to learn about an Artist called Joan Miro! He started out painting and drawing but then began to experiment with more unusual materials.
Personal, Social and Emotional	In PSHE, this half-term is all being our best. We will be talking about our core values of Self- Belief and Resilience and knowing that we are capable of achieving anything we want to! We will talk about how we can bounce back when things go wrong before touching on some healthy living too including keeping our bodies and minds healthy.
PE	This half-term PE will be on a Wednesday. We will continue to revise and develop our fundamental movement skills. Please make sure all uniform and PE kits are labelled with names!
Homework & Spellings	For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly and continue to practise the sounds they have learnt. We will send home a phonic activity or a Maths activity every alternate week. This is due in on a Thursday. Maths activities can be shared on dojo.
