Summer 1	Year 6
English	We are looking at a poem called The Lion and Albert and producing pieces of writing based on this. During this topic we will be trying to tick off as many of the Year 6 writing criteria as possible!
Maths	We will be working hard to get prepared for our SATs! We are doing fractions, decimal and percentages as well as area and volume. However, we will continue to look at any areas in maths the children are feeling less confident with.
Science	This half term we will be studying light. We will be looking at how light travels and explain how we actually see.
Geography	Our geography topic this half term is looking at where our food comes from.
Art/DT	We will be looking at electrical circuits in D.T.
Computing	In computing, we are looking at 3D modelling.
PSHE	This half term we are looking at being our best. We will be discussing our life aspirations and discussing risks and how to stay safe.

RE	In R.E. this half term we are looking at Buddhism.
