



Stubbins Primary School Curriculum Planner

Summer 1	Year 4
English	This term, children will explore <i>Where the Forest Meets the Sea</i> by Jeannie Baker. They will focus on non-fiction writing, creating their own information boards.
Maths	Children will continue developing their understanding of decimals and will apply this knowledge to money and time. They will also explore shape, statistics, and position and direction, building confidence in problem-solving and real-life mathematical applications.
Science	In science, pupils will study <i>States of Matter</i> . They will learn about solids, liquids, and gases, and investigate how materials change state through processes such as heating and cooling.
Geography	Pupils will explore the question " <i>What is amazing about the Amazon?</i> " They will learn about the rainforest environment, its importance to the planet, and the people and wildlife that live there.
Art	In Art, children will explore <i>printing techniques</i> , experimenting with patterns, textures, and different materials to create their own artwork.
Computing	In computing, children will study <i>photo editing</i> . They will learn how to manipulate images digitally and understand how media can be changed and improved using technology.
PSHE	This term's focus is <i>Being My Best</i> . Children will learn about setting goals, developing resilience, and making healthy lifestyle choices to support their wellbeing.
PE	This term includes <i>Outdoor and Adventurous Activities (OAA)</i> and <i>cricket</i> . Pupils will develop teamwork, coordination, and strategic skills through a range of physical challenges.
RE	In RE, children will study <i>Islam</i> , focusing on Ramadan. They will learn about the reasons for fasting, the importance of commitment, and the impact this has on Muslims.
Music	In Year 4 Music, pupils will explore <i>expression and improvisation</i> . They will experiment with creating their own music and expressing emotions through sound.
Homework & Spellings	<p>For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly, practise their spellings and complete their weekly maths homework. This is due in on a Thursday. Spellings will be sent home in your child's home learning book, on a Monday, and tested the following Monday in school.
