Summer 2	Year Five
English	Based on the book, Radiant Child by Javaka Steptoe, we learn about the artist Jean-Michell Basquiat and then use this to inspire our writing piece, an information text about Jean-Michel Basquiat suitable for an art gallery.
Maths	In maths, we will continue our work on position and direction and then moving onto adding and subtracting decimals.
Science	Animals and their habitats is our topic for this half term, recapping lifecycles and the reproduction and gestation periods of different animals
History	This half term we learn all about the Ancient Egyptians, ordering events on a timeline, understanding their beliefs and incredible developments, plus how this ancient civilisation has impacted on our lives today.
Art/DT	We will be potraits using collages techniques using textiles.
Computing	Pupils develop their knowledge of selection by revisiting how conditions can be used in programs and then learning how the If... Then... Else structure can be used to select different outcomes using the Scratch programming environment
PSHE	We will look the ways our bodies grow and change.
PE	We will be looking at athletics further and practising our skills ready for our sports day later this half term. We will also look at the team sport hockey and refine our skills!
RE	We will study Judaism, The Torah, Laws and guidance and The synagogue
Music	In music, we are learning how to compose pieces of music and developing our use of chords.
French	In French, we will be continuing to recap different units and learn about different food, commenting on what we like and dislike and pratising how to order food in French.
Homework & Spellings	<p>For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly, practise their spellings and complete their weekly maths homework. This is due in on a Thursday. Spellings will be sent home in your child's home learning book, on a Friday, and tested the following Friday in school.</p> <p>There will also be a whole school core value challenge you can complete if you want to.
