Summer 2	Reception
English - Literacy	In our English, we are reading "The Sea Saw" by Tom Percival. We are learning to retell and rewrite the story using sentences which include capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be applying our Level 2 and Level 3 sound knowledge and we will continue to write longer words including four and five sound words or two-syllable words.
Maths	In Maths this half-term, we will continue to develop our understanding of number through practical activities and investigations. We will explore sharing and grouping, begin to recognise doubles and continue to build confidence when solving problems. We will also explore repeating patterns, maps, positional language and building models before making connections between all of the maths we have learnt throughout Reception. We will continue to use practical resources, songs, games and discussion to develop our mathematical thinking and reasoning skills.
Understanding the World	Our topic this half-term is all about Journeys! In this topic, we will begin to explore the past, present and future tenses in more detail. We will explore different holiday destinations and the different types of transport which may be used. We will explore the similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries around the world.
Expressive Arts and Design	In Art this half-term, we will be creating sculptures using different materials. We will study the Artist Brendan Jamison who created different models from sugar cubes! We will then explore different types of materials which can be used to create our own sculptures and we will be making our own vehicles!
Personal, Social and Emotional	In PSHE, this half-term is all about growing and changing. Within this topic, we will begin to look at how seasons change before looking in more depth at the human life cycle and how we grow and change. More information about this topic will be sent to parents over the coming weeks.
PE	This half-term PE will be on a Wednesday. In PE, we will continue to revise and develop our fundamental movement skills. Please make sure all uniform and PE kits are labelled with names!

Homework & Spellings

For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly and practise the sounds they have learnt. We will send home a phonic activity or a maths activity every alternate week. This is due in on a Thursday. Maths activities can be shared on dojo.

There will also be a whole school core value challenge you can complete if you want to. We would love to see photos/ videos on class dojo! These will be celebrated at the end of the half-term.
