Summer 2	Year 6
English	We are looking at a poem called The Lion and Albert and producing pieces of writing based on this. During this topic we will be trying to tick off as many of the Year 6 writing criteria as possible!
Maths	We will be working on properties of shapes and angles. We will be measuring and drawing angles accurately and using our shape knowledge to work out missing angles.
Science	In Science we will be looking at electricity. We will be building circuits and learning how electricity can be generated.
History	Our history topic this half term asks whether all people were treated equally in British history. We will be looking at the civil rights movements and learning about Martin Luther King Jr too.
DT/Computing	We will be programming micro bits to make a step counter.
PSHE	This half term's focus is 'Growing and Changing'. We will be discussing if we can really trust pictures we see in the media and thinking about media pressure. We will also be discussing how our bodies change and reproduction. Information will be sent out about this before the time!
PE	This half term we will be doing netball and tennis.
RE	Our Religious Education lessons will focus on Christianity and the church.
Music	We will mainly be looking at our songs for the end of year performance in preparation for an amazing show!
