Autumn 1	Year 1
English	<u>Writing outcome = Adventure Story 'Lost and Found'</u> In English this half-term we are reading the text Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. We are learning to write our own adventure story using the structure of Lost and Found but with a new animal. In phonics, the children will continue to develop their reading and writing skills through Level 5. They will learn new ways of representing familiar sounds, practise blending sounds to read words and segmenting words to spell them. We will also continue to develop their recognition of tricky words. <u>Class Novels</u> All about Penguins by Emily Bone Zoo-ology by Joelle Jolivet On the way home by Jill Murphy
Maths	<u>Place Value</u> We are developing our number knowledge by studying place value. We will be sorting and comparing objects, counting them, writing numbers as words and counting on from any number. This half-term will consolidate our number knowledge within 10.
Science	<u>Animals including humans</u> In Science, we are studying Animals including humans. We will exploring which animals belong to different groups and which animals are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
Geography	<u>What is our country like?</u> This half-term builds on our place knowledge of our own local area. We will be learning which countries make up the United Kingdom and naming the surrounding seas. We will study our capital city London in greater detail.
DT	<u>Structures</u> This term, Year 1 will study the engineers The Wright Brothers and learn how to design, build and evaluate their own piece of playground equipment, working together to create a class model playground.
Computing	<u>Technology around us</u> We will be developing our understanding of technology this half-term. We will be learning how technology can help us in the wider world and becoming familiar with different components of a computer.
PSHE	<u>Me and my relationships</u> As always in Autumn 1, this half-term is about developing relationships and settling into Year 1. The children will build on their Reception year helping them to develop emotionally and socially.
PE	Our PE days will be Tuesday and Wednesday.

	During PE lessons, the children will develop their fundamental movement skills, including running, throwing, hopping and skipping. We will also focus specifically on developing their ball-rolling skills.
RE	<u>Christianity - Why do Christians say God is a Father?</u> Our RE topic this half-term is Christianity. We will begin to understand who God is and why Christians follow God.
Music	<u>My musical heartbeat</u> In Music, we are beginning to introduce beat. We will build on the work of Reception where children began to copy simple rhythms and patterns.
Homework & Spellings	For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly and complete their maths homework which will be sent home on a Friday. Please can reading records be signed and kept in school bags. Homework is to be handed in on a Thursday and will be sent home on a Friday.  Children have access to numbots which is a brilliant online game to help with their maths learning – login details can be found in the front of home learning books☺ There is also a twinkl login in the front of home learning books.
