Autumn 1		Year 6
English	We will be looking at King Kong by Anthony Browne and creating pieces of writing as we read through the story. The final outcome will be some adventure story writing.	
Maths	This half term we will be looking at place value of numbers up to 10,000,000 and we will be looking at written and mental methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.	
Science	In Science our topic is evolution and inheritance. We will be looking at how living things adapt over time and how things are inherited.	
Geography	We will be looking at China and its human and physical geography. We will then be comparing a major city in China to a major city in England.	
PSHE	This half term's focus is 'Me and My Relationships'. This unit covers working together, solving friendship problems, being responsible for our own behaviour and being assertive.	
PE	This half term we will be doing netball and tennis.	
RE	Our Religious Education lessons will focus on Christianity and God.	
Music	This half term we will be focussing on music and technology.	
Computing	Computing systems and networks – communication and collaboration. We will be looking at how computers communicate with each other over a network.	
Homework & Spellings	For homework, your child is expected to read their reading book regularly, practise their spellings and complete their weekly maths and reading homework. This is due in on a Thursday. Spellings will be sent home in your child's home learning book, on a Friday, and tested the following Friday in school.
