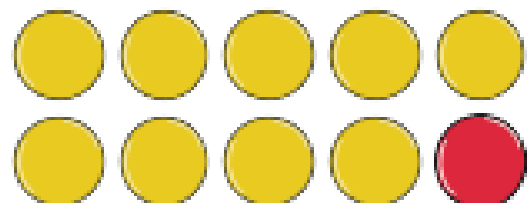

Number Bonds of 10

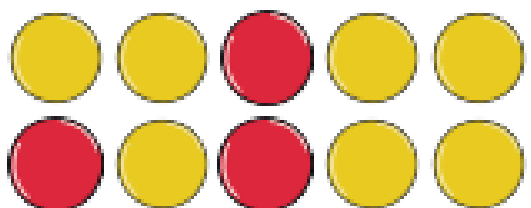
Look at the counters. Using two coloured pencils, can you show them on the ten-frames? Can you complete each number sentence?
