



<p>Roddlesworth Cycle A Autumn 2 2021</p> 	<p><u>Why should Britain be ashamed of the slave trade?</u></p>		
<p>English: This half term Roddlesworth will be exploring older/classic literature and looking at the novel the Secret Garden. We will be looking at how language is used throughout and will be creating our own stories using some key techniques that we discover along the way. For our non-fiction unit, we will be looking at newspaper reports and becoming amazing journalists through writing our own.</p>	<p>Maths: Throughout this half term, Roddlesworth will be developing their understanding of multiplication and division, deepening their ability to use methods with confidence and efficiency. We will then be looking at measure, specifically measure, perimeter and area- we will be able to apply our prior knowledge of our four calculations to help us.</p>	<p>Topic: History <u>Why should Britain be ashamed of the slave trade?</u> Our topic for this half term is related to the slave trade, looking at significant events in History and beyond 1066. We will be looking at how Britain was involved in the slave trade. We will consider how slaves were moved from Africa to America. We will be looking at influential people and the work of significant people such as William Wilberforce who had an impact on bringing an end to the slave trade. We will be considering the impact of this on society today and how this compares to modern day life.</p>	
<p>Science: This half term in Science we will be looking at material changes- focusing on reversible and irreversible changes with our key question being do things disappear? We will be looking at how a material dissolves to form a solution, know and show how to recover a substance from a solution. We will investigate how some materials can be separated e.g. through filtering, sieving and evaporating) By the end of our unit we will know and demonstrate that some changes are reversible and some are not.</p>	<p>Computing: During this half term we will be looking at web page creation, thinking about content, structure, and design. We will also be focusing on online safety and the consequences of spending too much time online or on a game. We will consider how to use the internet safely and appropriately.</p>	<p>Art / DT: This half term we will be underdoing our design and technology unit. We will be looking at mechanical and electrical systems and within this we will be designing and making a pulley system using electronics.</p>	<p>RE: Christianity- God How and why might Christians use the Bible? During this half term our focus will be how and why Christians use the bible and why the Bible is seen as a source of inspiration and authority by many Christians.</p>
<p>PE: Dance This half term our PE focus will be dance. Children are given the opportunity to develop flexibility, strength, technique, control, and balance. They will be looking at performing dances using a range of movement patterns and compare their performances with previous ones.</p>	<p>PSHE: Identity, society, and equality. This half term we will be looking at rules and laws. We will be considering what the difference is between them. By the end of the unit, we will understand what it takes to be a citizen and the differences in our society.</p>	<p>MFL: In the city and at Christmas Roddlesworth will be asking and answering questions in Spanish and looking and using specific nouns and verbs.</p>	<p>Music: Roddlesworth will have a weekly Ukulele session. They will develop their skills of playing an instrument and learning to play a song.</p>
