<p>English: Children will read stories that are set in familiar settings and write their own story. Children will also learn about the structure and language of instructions and then will write their own instructions. Class Novel: A Bear Called Paddington</p>	<p>Maths: Children will develop their understanding of place value with numbers up to 100 (Y2) and 1,000 (Y3). They will learn mental and written strategies to add and subtract and solve problems involving money.</p>	<p>Topic: History Great fire of London. Children will learn about the Great Fire of London and will learn about the importance of Samuel Pepys and his diary. Children will identify some similarities and differences between ways of life in 1666 and now. They will learn where some people and events fit into a chronological framework, using common words and phrases about the passing of time (<i>before, after, a long time ago, past...</i>). We hope to have a visit from the Fire Brigade.</p>	
<p>Science: Habitats: Children will learn that a habitat is a place that an animal lives. It provides the animal with food, water and shelter. There are many different sorts of habitats around the world from forests to grasslands and from mountain slopes to deserts.</p>	<p>Computing: Programming: Children will use simple programming software to write and debug an algorithm. They will learn how to predict the outcome of an algorithm.</p>	<p>Art / DT: Digital Media Children will record and collect visual information using digital cameras and video recorders. They will present recorded visual images using software. Artist: David Hockney</p>	<p>RE: Christianity – God Does how we treat the world matter? This enquiry explores Christian beliefs about God as creator and sustainer and consider how these beliefs might influence Christian attitudes towards the planet.</p>
<p>PE: Invasion games Children will be learning to play Touch Ball, applying their skills and understanding from previous years. Children will improve their throwing and catching and will learn new techniques and strategies.</p>	<p>PSHE: Me and my relationships Children will learn about feelings and how they can manage feelings. Children will consider what makes a good friend and what to do if someone is being teased or bullied.</p>	<p>MFL: Children will identify and respond to simple questions in Spanish. They will identify simple nouns and some word families.</p>	<p>Music: Children will listen to music from South Africa and will discuss styles, find the pulse, recognise instruments, and discuss other dimensions of music. They will work together to create and perform their own melody and response.</p>
