



Reception Home Learning Expectations

- Children should read or share a book at home at least three times per week. This can include: their school reading book, a library book or other books from home.
- Children should practice reading and spelling their five identified words. These will be linked to the sounds and corresponding graphemes children have learnt in school as part of their Read Write Inc Phonics lessons.
- Each week the class teacher will identify three curriculum words, which children have explored in class that week, linked to their curriculum project. Please discuss these words with children to further support their understanding.
- Children will be set a weekly Maths task via Purple Mash.
- Children are encouraged to access Numbots to develop their understanding of number and place value.
- Children will be set learning tasks from their termly Cornerstones curriculum project to support their learning. Children should complete activities in their Home Learning book. Please choose at least two activities, but feel free to complete more.

Your child's class teacher will notify you of the day that homework should be returned.

All children have received their login and passwords to access the different learning platforms. These can be found inside their Home Reading Record. You can find the access links to all learning platforms on the relevant Class Pages on our school website.
