



KS1 Home Learning Expectations

- Children should read or share a book at home at least three times per week. This can include: their school reading book, a library book or other books from home.
- Children should practice their set weekly spellings. Children will have a spelling test in school each Friday. These will be chosen from the list of common exception words and their curriculum projects being studied, i.e. Science or History.
- Children will be set a weekly Maths task via Purple Mash.
- Children are encouraged to access Numbots and Timetable Rockstars (Year 2) in order to practise and apply knowledge and skills to improve fluency.
- Children will also be set learning tasks from their termly Cornerstones curriculum project.

Your child's class teacher will notify you of the day that homework should be returned.
