



KS2 Home Learning Expectations

- Children should read or share a book at home at least three times per week. This can include: their school reading book, a library book or other books from home. Children also have access to the My Book Blog platform and should read two books on My Book Blog each half term, and complete the linked activities.
- Children should practice their set weekly spellings. Children will have a spelling test in school each Friday. These will be chosen from the list of common exception words and their curriculum projects being studied, i.e. Science or History.
- Children will be set a weekly Maths task via Purple Mash.
There will also be a task set via Times Tables Rockstars to improve speed and fluency of times tables.
- Children will also be set learning tasks from their termly Cornerstones curriculum project.

Your child's class teacher will notify you of the day that homework should be returned.

All children have received their login and passwords to access the different learning platforms. These can be found in their Home Reading Record. You can find the access links to learning platforms on the relevant Class Pages on our school website.
