

## Homework

Homework will be given out on the first Friday of the half-term, which will consist of a range different learning activities. Children will be expected to complete at least 6 of these activities over the half-term. Children should bring in their completed homework or send a picture to the class teacher via Seesaw.

## Knowledge Organisers

At Hackwood Primary Academy we have Knowledge Organisers (KOs), to help children learn the language they need for each topic they study. In Reception we include vocabulary that we want children to be familiar with by the end of the topic. We expect the majority of children to be able to recall all of the information on the KO by the end of the topic.

## Reading

Your child will have a reading book and high frequency words, which will need to be taken home and returned to school EVERY day. Your child should read at home every day and an adult will need to sign to show that your child has read to an adult. Reading diaries will be checked every week.

## School Uniform

Your child will need correct uniform and suitable clothing for outside play. As the weather gets colder and wetter, please send your children with hats, scarves, gloves and wellies.
