

Homework

Homework will be given out on the first Friday of the half-term, which will consist of at least 6 different learning activities. Children will be expected to complete these activities over the half-term and record them via the iPads or in their jotters. Children should bring in their completed homework by the end of each half term. This can either be weekly or all in one go.

Knowledge Organisers

At Hackwood Primary Academy we have Knowledge Organisers (KOs) in class and as homework, to help children learn the essential knowledge they need for each topic they study. A Knowledge Organiser sets out in detail what we want children to know by heart by the end of the topic. We expect the majority of children to be able to recall all of the information on the KO by the end of the topic.

Reading

Your child will have a reading diary, which will need to be taken home and returned to school every day. Your child should read at home at least 3 times a week and an adult will need to sign to show that your child has read to an adult. Reading diaries will be checked every week.

PE Kits

Your child will need correct PE kit. As the weather gets colder, we will allow children to wear dark jogging bottoms. We will be doing PE every week on Monday and Wednesday.

Please ensure your child is wearing the correct school uniform everyday and please make sure that all clothing is clearly labelled.

Science

In maths we will be learning all about place value. We will begin by recapping our knowledge of value columns and the value of each digit in a number. We will also learn about Roman numerals

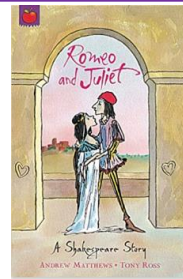
We will then move on to using these skills to practise written and mental methods for addition and subtraction.
