Reading:

Physical Activity:

Maths:

Practise counting to 10 and beyond each day.

Personal, Social and Emotional

Draw a picture of your family. Talk about why you love each person in your family. What do they do that makes you happy?



Mathematics

Create a treasure map!

Describe how to find the treasure to your grown up and follow the map!



Understanding the World

Go on a nature walk and use your senses.

What can you see, smell, hear and touch around you?

Can you see anything growing? Can you see any animals or insects?



Expressive Arts and Design

Use an old sock to create a puppet.
You could use string, wool, buttons, ribbon, felt, etc.



Physical Development

Create an obstacle course! Encourage the children to use movements such as crawling, jumping, balancing.
