Weekly Essentials

Reading:

Enjoy story time with your grown up for 10 minutes every day. This can be reading a story at bedtime or making up your own with teddies.

Physical Activity:

Take part in some physical activity every day. Choose from a number of wake and shake songs on YouTube.

Maths:

Practise counting to 10 and beyond each day.

The **knowledge organiser** and **class newsletter** has lots of information and facts for you to use and help you with your learning too.

Personal, Social and Emotional

Can you help around the house?

Here are some example tasks:

- Laying the table,
- Spreading butter and jam on toast,
- Pouring cereal and milk into a bowl,
- Clearing the table after eating.

<u>Mathematics</u>

Create a repeating pattern with objects from around your house. Start simple with the same object but different colours.

If you want a challenge, try using two different objects such as stones and sticks.



Understanding the World

Look out of your window and talk about what modes of transport you can see.

Can you answer these questions:
What modes of transport might we find on the road?

How can we travel on or under water?

Expressive Arts and Design

Using some recycling, junk model a mode of transport. Have a look at some pictures with your grown up to inspire you.





Physical Development

Can you practise riding a bike or scooter?
If you want a challenge, try riding in, out and around obstacles such as cones, trees or toys.
Remember to wear a helmet. Why is it important to wear one?



Literacy/Phonics

When out and about have a look for letters that you know.

Have a go at reading words with the help of your grown up. Sound the words out and blend the sounds together to work out the word.
