"What makes me special?"



Find some items of clothing around your house with different fastenings. Practise fastening them: zips, buttons, poppers, Velcro, toggles... Try to do them independently, Practise putting



on your coat.

Personal, social, and emotional (Understanding emotions)



Can you talk about how you are feeling? At school, we will introduce the zones of regulation and learn to discuss our different feelings and emotions.

Expressive arts and design

Choose your favourite colour. Create a poster full

one to show different colours.


Communication and
