



# Year | INSPIRE Curriculum Newsletter - Autumn |


In our Geography lessons, Year I will be observing and describing our local area. We will create maps of the classroom, school grounds and learn about compass directions. We will be going on a local area walk around Mickleover and enjoy a visit from 'Little City'.



- To use geographical vocabulary to describe what the local area and my school grounds are like
- To create a map of school
- To know what an aerial image is and label the geographical features on it.

















We will be reading a variety of non-fiction texts linked to our topic to build our reading skills. We will also read fiction stories this half term such as Funny bones, You and the Universe and My beautiful voice.

In writing lessons, we will be making personal choices about our dream world based on the book 'You choose' by Nick Sharatt. This introductory unit will support early writing development by helping us label images and write sentences with finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. We will create wanted posters and innovate our own losing story called 'Lost in Hackwood' based on the 'Lost in the toy museum' book by David Lucas.

In Art lessons, we will develop our drawing and sketching skills. We will learn about the artist Andy Warhol and create some pop-art self portraits. We will draft our self portraits, taking care to place our eyes, nose, ears and mouth in the correct place.



## Year I Curriculum Newsletter – Autumn I



In maths, we will be diving into the foundations of number and shape through the White Rose Maths curriculum. The focus is on building confidence with numbers up to 10 and developing key mathematical language and reasoning skills.

#### 🖈 Key Learning Areas:

#### Place Value (within 10):

- Sorting, counting and representing objects
- Reading and writing numbers as digits and words
- · Finding one more and one less
- · Comparing and ordering numbers
- · Using number lines to support understanding

#### Addition and Subtraction (within 10):

- Exploring part-whole models
- · Writing number sentences
- · Understanding fact families and number bonds to 10
- · Using concrete resources and pictorial representations to solve problems.

Throughout the term, children will be encouraged to use practical resources, visual models and mathematical vocabulary to deepen their understanding. The aim is to develop fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills in a fun and engaging way
