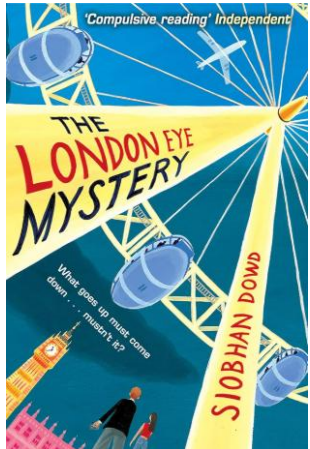

In Art lessons, we will be exploring the work of Robert Rauschenberg. We will also be creating an art piece using the skill of image transfer.

In Science we are learning all about Electricity. We will learn about what a circuit is and what is needed to create a circuit.

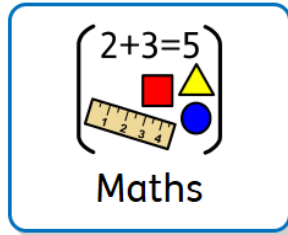
