


# Nursery INSPIRE Curriculum Newsletter – Spring 1

# Nursery Curriculum Newsletter – Spring 1



## Communication and Language

During this topic we will be learning new vocab and the meaning of these words. The children will be encouraged to use these new words during their play. We will meet visitors from different occupations and ask questions about their jobs.



## Personal, Social and Emotional

The children will be encouraged to communicate their emotions daily and will be taught regulation techniques and vocabulary to communicate their feelings to adults and other children. Circle times will be used for the children to share what they have done at the weekend, as well as talk about different topics such as safe adults and Chinese New Year.



## Physical Development

This half term we will be doing lots of physical literacy to strengthen and develop our muscles. We will practise balancing, rolling, throwing, catching and jumping safely. There will be fine motor activities such as playdough, threading and rice play available every day to encourage fine motor development that will support early mark making.




## Literacy

This half term we will have lots of opportunities for early reading and mark making. We will be introduced to a range of different text types such as lists and instructions. We will also have a big focus on recognising our written name, in readiness for beginning to write our name in the next half term.




## Understanding the World

This term's topic focuses on: different occupations, exploring how different people can help us, developing positive attitudes about the differences between people, thinking about what I want to be when I grow up



## Expressive Arts and Design

There will be opportunities for the children to create pictures and junk model freely throughout the term. A variety of different resources will be available for the children to explore. We will also create some focused art pieces based around people who help us.



## Maths

Our maths focuses this half term are: counting to 10, 2D shapes (selecting appropriate shapes), Counting 'How many?' To 5 (cardinal principle), Capacity (full and empty), Recognising numbers to 5, Describing routes and locations
