Weekly Essentials

Reading:

Read for 10-20 minutes everyday. This can be your reading book, a book from home or your library book

Spelling:

Practise your weekly spelling that are in your reading record diary and on Seesaw. Practise using them in sentences too!

Maths:

Practise counting in 2s and writing the different number bonds of 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Science:

This half term we will learn about different animals. Can you draw or make a list of all the different mammals, fish, birds, reptiles and amphibians you know?

Geography:

Can you make a map which shows the different locations of the countries that form the United Kingdom?
