Queen Victoria reigned for 63 years

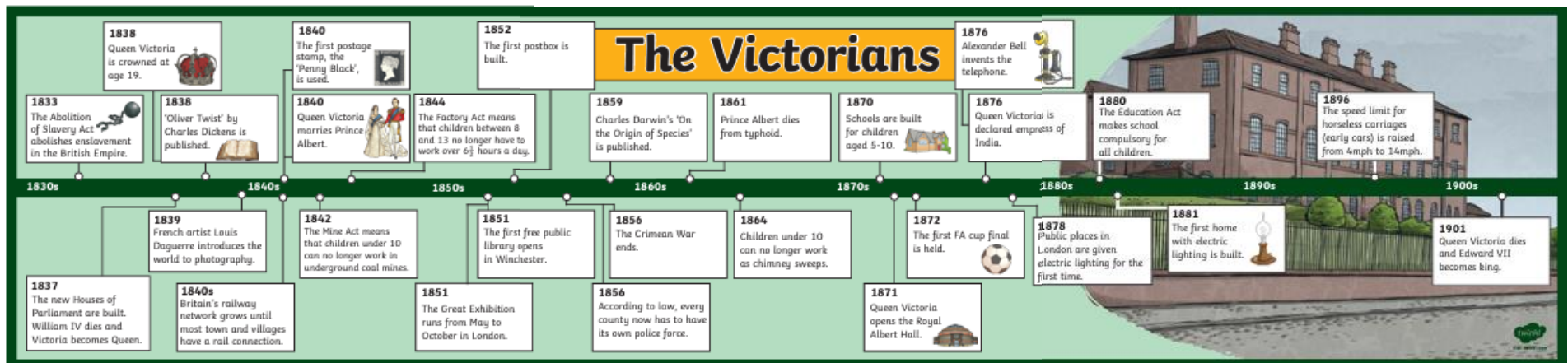
Queen Victoria was married to Prince Albert until he died of Typhoid
