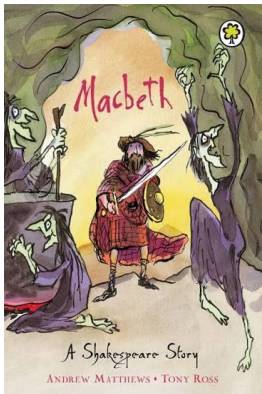

Our key texts for reading this half term will be a range of fiction and non-fiction texts focused on the Tudor period. One text we will focus on is “Macbeth a Shakespeare Story”.

In writing lessons, we will continue to develop our use of a wide range of punctuation. We will be writing a playscript based on what we have read about Romeo and Juliet.

We will also write a diary entry from the perspective on Henry VIII or one of his wives.

In Art we will be using water colours to create our own Tudor style miniatures in the style of Nicholas Hilliard and Isaac Oliver. The children will learn sketching skills along side painting skills.



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Science

In science lessons, we will learn about Forces. We will learn about different types of forces and how they affect the world around us.



music

In music lessons, we will learn to sing songs and play the glockenspiel inspired by the genre of rock music starting with Bon Jovi Livin' on a Prayer.



PE

In PE lessons, we will be learning orienteering skills with soccer stars on a Thursday and taking part in the Joy of Movement programme with Derby County on a Tuesday.

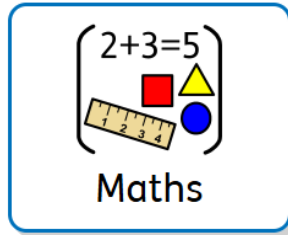
