

Kit List for Y3 and Y4 Residential – 20th–22nd March 2024

Here is a list of things you'll need to pack. Nearer the time, we'll send out a letter with reminders of what to do on the morning of 20th March including when we're planning to set off. The list isn't exhaustive but gives you an idea of what pupils will need. The children will need to pack their belongings when we leave, so a crash course in packing before they go would be great! Bedding is provided by the centre.

	Warm layers – jumpers, sweatshirts, hoodies		1x Packed lunch – no nuts – in a small rucksack
	Trainers or other outdoor shoes x2		Reusable water bottle
	Wellies (optional)		Towel
	Warm, waterproof coat with a hood		Wash kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap/shower gel, shampoo, etc.)

	Slippers / sliders		Books, colouring, quiet games such as cards

	Teddy / cuddly toy – essential!		Torch

A few things to remember:

- Medication to be handed to staff on the day clearly labelled with the pupil's name and dosage
- Clothes may get dirty, so bring old clothes that you're happy to get muddy!
- Jeans are **not suitable** for the activities we'll be doing – tracksuit bottoms are best
- Please **do not** bring electronic games, cameras, radios, personal stereos or anything else that makes unnecessary noise or may get lost or broken. No mobile phones, please
- Please keep sugary snacks to a minimum – thank you! 😊
- **No aerosols** please (the smoke detectors in the bedrooms are extremely sensitive and will be triggered by sprays)
- We advise bringing a suitcase or soft holdall as it's easier than a rucksack to pack and keep tidy
- Packed lunches for the first day can be ordered from the school kitchen
- And finally, PLEASE label EVERYTHING! It'll make things so much easier!
