AA	2026-2027 Class Arrangements.	<p>Parents have been enquiring about when information on the class arrangements for 2026-2027 and transition arrangements will be shared. Transition week will take place during the last week of June, with further details to be communicated to parents shortly.</p> <p>Preschool parents have also raised questions regarding the home visits that are usually part of Reception class transition arrangements. As Miss Hornby is going on maternity leave, the school is currently in the process of recruiting maternity cover. Once appointed, the school will need to confirm whether the new member of staff is available during the transition week to support transition arrangements and home visits. Again, further information will be shared with parents as soon as possible.</p>	
SH	Tractor Tyres	Parents raised concerns following an incident in which a child was injured while playing with the	

		<p>tractor, and asked whether children could be discouraged from picking them up.</p> <p>It was explained that the tractor tyres form part of the school's loose parts play provision. As with all other playground equipment, the tyres have been risk assessed and are regularly checked as part of the school's health and safety procedures. Staff will continue to supervise play appropriately and reinforce safe use of equipment with children.</p>
