

FLANIMAL DAY

Flanimal day has been good fun. The children have dressed in a colour to show their favourite Flanimal. I met over 50 families this morning at the information session. They then stayed to visit their children during a Flanimal session in class and then we finished the afternoon with a Flanimal game in class. The characters capture and use key mental mathematics concept, ideas and methods but present them in a



more appealing, attractive and memorable way which we hope will capture the children's interest as they gather and use these strategies and methods until they leave in Year 6. As ever, we like to study what our learners show us in terms of interest, knowledge and any gaps in learning and then respond with a very personalised and innovative set of methods and approaches. I introduced the children to the FLANIMALS CHANT this morning - so apologies to any one who has to listen to it all weekend! Its called 'Fe-Fi-Flanimals'.

This is the first of our family information and classroom visit events this year. Each is wrapped up in a particular subject area and gives you chance to know more about them and then see them in practice, so, when you chat at home about the school day, help with studies outside of school or want to know what you can do to revise and extend things at home these events should help. We have used Parent Celebrations and Parent Assemblies in the past, we hope this latest methods of visits to school will help to inform and share what we are doing across the curriculum. The Reading Gang are the next focus before Christmas.
