## Parent Governor Election

### Notice of Election

There is a vacancy for parent governor on the governing body of Mayfield Primary School. They are elected by the parents of pupils at this school to serve a four year term of office. You may, if you wish, put yourself forward for election, using the attached application form and biographical details.

We are sending out the application form and biographical details form electronically where possible in word format – paper copies can be obtained upon request at the school office if you prefer.

The governing body would ideally like to recruit people who have an understanding of the education sector and potentially have experience working in this area. These have been identified as areas of experience that they would like to fill on the governing body. **We strongly recommend any interested parties contacting Mr Denton at school to discuss the expectations of being a governor in terms of expectations and hours volunteered to the role before applying. There is a significant commitment to this role – please be aware of this.**

(Voting will only take place if there are more nominations than vacancies.)

Ballot papers to be returned to Mr Denton by 9.30am on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2026.

The votes will be counted on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> January at 11.30am after which the result will be announced.

There is an expectation that the elected governors will work alongside the Headteacher to gain a detailed understanding of the school and its current position during an induction period shortly after election.
