SPORTS COOL SUMMER OFFER

We are delighted to release full details of our Summer Holiday Club offer in conjunction from our friends and colleagues at Sports Cool Fylde. Emma Williams at Sports Cool has worked hard to produce the four week offer running here for Mayfield children during the Summer break. As far as possible, we are always keen for this offer to be free of charge and we have been able to guarantee a significant number of free places. We encourage you to ask school if you think you may be eligible for the funded places equally contacting Emma at Sports Cool to discuss funded place options is recommended. Where school can help with funded places we will. The club runs from Week 2 to Week 5 of the Summer break for four days each week so is a great chance to keep the children busy, active and focused. HOT WEATHER NOTICES

We are told that the peak of the current temperatures will be Thursday afternoon, as this is our football afternoon and football club day, we have taken the early precautionary decision to cancel all outdoor football clubs and activities that afternoon. All children normally attending football clubs on Thursday after school will finish at 3.15pm instead this week.

There are revisions to some other outdoor clubs this week that we have also contacted families about.

Our sports style uniform is particularly helpful at times like this, as shorts and t-shirts are part of this on any day. Clearly we recommend shorts, white t-shirt and summer dresses at this time of year in most conditions but especially so at the moment.

Sun hats are more than welcome in school, sun screen must be applied before the children arrive for the school day but is clearly welcomed. Water bottles remain in operation as ever and we will review outdoor Brain Breaks and lunchtimes as we assess conditions at the time during the coming days. This is always the case anyway, usually referring to cold weather, but we equally do this in warm weather as well. We will determine whether indoors or outdoors is the best setting for social times in the expected warm weather conditions - most notably Thursday afternoon.

Children should attend school as normal through such warm weather conditions.
