The final **Sports Afternoon of 2026 is this coming Monday 6th July**. It's the re-arranged Year 5&6 event starting at 1.30pm with the playground gates opening for family entrance shortly beforehand.

Optional Report Parent Meetings are on Monday after school. Appointments have been sorted. Families who attend receive their child's report with supporting narrative. All other families choosing not to receive them in person will have copies given to their children on Tuesday 7th July to bring home.

The Department for Education contacted all primary schools in the country yesterday to inform us that Year 6 SAT results being returned to school has been delayed by a week. They will now be released to schools across the country on **Thursday 16th July instead of Tuesday 7th July**. This is disappointing but beyond our control. As soon as we have the results we will inform the children concerned.

New class visits take place next Thursday morning. The two hour visit to meet their new teacher, room and supporting adults is from 9.30 until 11.30 so it is a normal arrival, lunchtime and departure for everyone that day via their usual current classroom doors.

All extra-curricular clubs end next Thursday 9th July as advertised. New clubs offer for 2026/2027 academic year will be released in the first week back in September.

SEPTEMBER UPDATES

Just a couple of notices regarding September. Only the current Year 4 class setting will be changing for September 2026. The current Year 4 room will be moving onto the 'topside' of the building adjacent to the playground in the room currently occupied by Mr Baer's Year 5 class. We will revise the collection and drop off areas in the playground over the summer to allow for this. All other year group classrooms are remaining in the same places.

There are no revisions to any aspect of uniform for September. The full list continues to be on the website with the various 'do's and don'ts' on there.
