CLUBS OFFER 2026/2027

We released our clubs and wider curriculum offer yesterday for the coming year. Sign up/booking forms for Autumn Term were released at the same time in paper form to each child and the year calendar electronically. Paper booking forms must be sent back to the main school office by Friday 11th September. We will inform families of the outcomes on Friday or Monday 14th, with clubs starting from next week: Tuesday 15th September.

We have kept in the most popular clubs and moved out the few less popular ones. We have again worked hard to ensure that there is an offer for all year groups on each of the days throughout the year. Again, staff have volunteered their time to make the offer work ensuring we can offer a range of subjects and areas of interest.

We would like to welcome back Kylie Butler after a period of ill health. Kylie will resume her LAMDA sessions from Thursday 10th September with her Drama Club and any new LAMDA children beginning the week after.

Both LAMDA and Keyboard sessions are the only ones with a cost as they are run by external professionals, usually on a 1-2-1 basis during the school day. Both LAMDA and keyboards are recruiting new children for this year. Expressions of interest can be made using our sign up/booking form.
