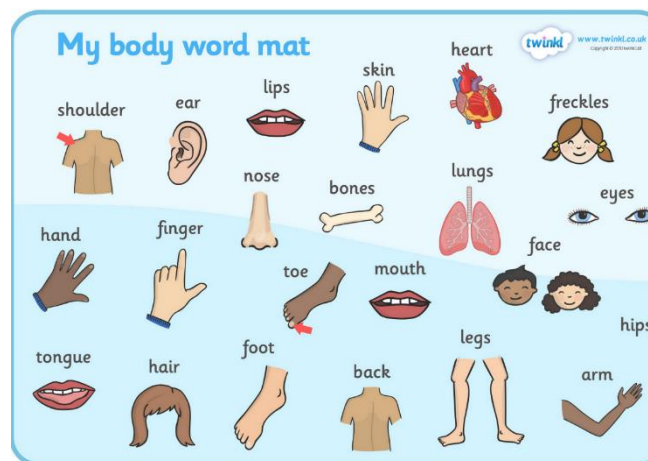

	Self portrait	A picture that we do of ourselves.
	Unique	We are all different and one of a kind.

	Harvest	The gathering of ripe crops.

What will I be learning? We will talk about ourselves, where we live, our friends and family and the similarities and differences between ourselves and others. We will look at the process of growing and changing from a baby to an adult. We will share special events that we have with our families including those during the summer holidays. We will compare and respect different family groups including at home, school and in the community. In maths we will use positional language, and explore numbers. We will focus on subitising (recognise amounts without counting) and the composition of numbers. We will sort, match, group and compare items by size including height, and length. In phonics will practise listening skills, rhyme, oral blending and segmenting. We will learn the grapheme phoneme correspondence for letters and apply them when recognising initial sounds and reading words. We will write our name and practise forming letters. We will learn about the importance of rules and why we have them to stay safe. The children will learn our Wales learning behaviour code and how they can help them become an active learner. We will discuss our feelings and what we like and dislike. The children will learn they are unique and why they are special. We will learn about Harvest and look at how seasons change.
