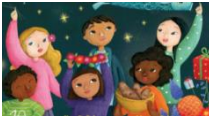

	Celebrate	To do something special to remember an important day.
	Festival	An event celebrated by a group of people.
	Anniversary	The date on which an event took place for example a birthday, wedding.
	Church	A place of worship for Christians and place to celebrate important days.
	Christmas	Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus. Christmas Day is celebrated on 25 th December.
	Advent	A time to prepare for Christmas before Christmas day.
	Tradition	To repeat special events in the same way every year.

What will I be learning?

We will share with the class how we celebrate special occasions with our family and friends. We will learn about different festivals around the world and compare how the events are celebrated. We will discuss changes that take place over time and will place key events in the children's life in chronological order. In maths we will look at partitioning in different ways to 5. We will explore and discuss the composition of numbers to 10. We will compare quantities and say one more and less than each number. In phonics we will continue to learn the phoneme for each letter and begin to recognise some digraphs. We will blend to read words and start to recognise tricky words (I, the, go, no, to, into.) We will practise forming letters when writing our name, words and short captions. We will discuss what makes a good friend and the importance of using kind, positive words and actions. We will continue to learn that everyone is different and respect and celebrate these differences.

Things to talk about together

- What do you celebrate with your family?
- Look at photos of your family celebrating. Talk about things you notice in the pictures.
- Discuss your families' traditions as part of these celebrations.
- Compare and discuss photos of your child's first birthday and a more recent birthday.
