SUMMER READING CHALLENGE!

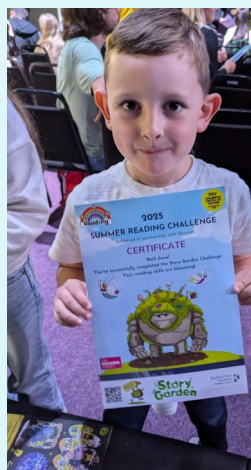

Junior Road Safety Officers 2025

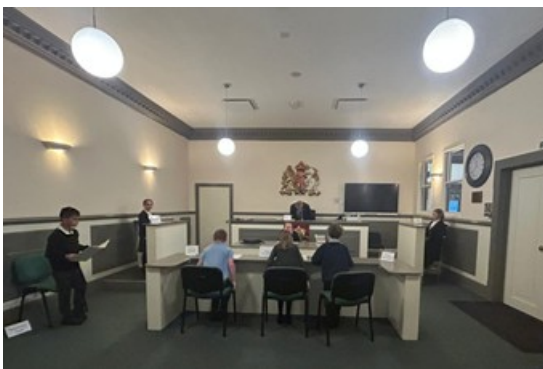
